Drought in Amazon Rainforest



<u>Context</u>: The Negro river, major tributory runs through the Brazilian Amazon, has reached historic lows, revealing millienia old carvings previously hidden underwater.

About Amazon Rainforest

- It is a moist broadleaf tropical rainforest in the Amazon biome that covers most of the Amazon basin of South America.
 - This basin encompasses 70 lakh
 km2 of which 55 lakh km2 are
 covered by the rainforest.
- This region includes territory belonging to nine countries and more than 3300 formally acknowledged indigenous territories.
- The majority of the forest, 60%, is in **Brazil**, followed by **Peru** with 13%, **Colombia** with 10%.
- Amazon, called the planet's lungs
 (storing more than 150 billion metric
 tonnes of carbon).
- Amazon river largest river by volume.

Prisoners Dilemma

<u>Context</u>: Defence Minister Rajnath Singh referred to the concept of "Prisoner's dilemma" at his keynote address at Goa Maritime Conclave, to underscore the need for countries to collaborate with each other instead of working at cross purposes.

- Two players make choices: The Prisoner's Dilemma involves two individuals who decide whether to cooperate or betray.
- Payoff matrix: Different choices
 result in specific payoffs, such as
 cooperation leading to moderate
 rewards, while betrayal can bring
 higher rewards if the other
 player cooperates.
- Rational self-interest: Players aim to maximize their individual gains by choosing what benefits them the most.
- Nash equilibrium: This is the situation where neither player wants to change their choice based on what the other player did, often leading to both players betraying each other.
- Suboptimal outcomes: Despite better collective results through cooperation, the dilemma shows how self-interested decisions can lead to less favorable outcomes, applicable in real-life scenarios like business and international relations.
