

- Taiwan democratic system, constitution, armed forces, seeks international recognition



#### **Chinese concerns**

- Taiwan's President Tsai Ing-wen
- Growing ties between Taiwan and the United States
- Taiwan's role in "first island chain"
- Semiconductor chips

#### **Role of USA**

- Supported the nationalist government of Taiwan in 1949
- 1979 Switched diplomatic recognition
- Taiwan Relations Act
- Policy of strategic ambiguity
- Military and diplomatic supportfrequent naval and air patrols
- Democratic partner and a counterweight to China's influence in the Indo-Pacific

#### **Indian interests**

- Trade: South China Sea dependence
- Common security concerns
- Democracy: common values of freedom, human rights, rule of law
- Technology: Digital transformation, startup ecosystem
- Culture: tourism, education, and people-to-people contacts.

#### • Materials

- Autoclaved Aerated Concrete (AAC) blocks, red bricks, fly ash, and monolithic concrete (Mivan)
- AAC blocks lowest RETV across all climatic conditions lower embodied energy
- But Monolithic concrete construction favoured
